Reflect: *Is there anything that you need help from Jesus? Is there any people or situations which you feel Jesus is calling you to help others?*

Jesus the Saviour

- Psalm 38:22, Psalm 68:19, Isaiah 19:20, Psalm 79:9, Micah 7:7, Luke 2:11*
- ⇒ *Jesus and Nicodemus ... Jesus is comparing himself to the story from Numbers 21:8-9. Just as the bronze snake was lifted up and everyone who looked upon it was saved, he too will be lifted up and everyone who looks to Jesus will be saved.*

Reflect: *How do we talk about Jesus the Saviour in our modern context? How would we explain to a non-churched person what Jesus can “save” them from?*
Ephesians 2:8-9, Acts 2:21, Romans 10:9-13

Challenge

1. How do we find a “language” that is more understandable to share Jesus our Saviour with others?
2. How do we live our 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 in your daily life?

“God helps us in all our troubles, so that we are able to help others who have all kinds of troubles, using the same help that we ourselves have received from God”


